On 26th March, 2010, Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ V ايده الله تعالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

In this Sermon, Ḥuḍūr المواللة cited various instances to illustrate the fact that Allāh is sufficient for those who adopt *Taqwa* and put their trust in Him, and that He provides for them through means that they cannot imagine. Ḥuḍūr المواللة also cited certain events that show how Allāh favours the believers and punishes those who oppose them.

Huḍūr الموالية said: All Prophets of Allāh are the ones who are most endowed with Divine attributes, and our Holy Prophet was the foremost among them. Such was his munificence and generosity that he distributed all the wealth that came to him and exhorted his followers not to be niggardly when spending in the cause of the faith, and not to start counting pennies when spending in the way of Allāh; otherwise Allāh would pay them back in the same manner. We should spend freely in the way of Allāh within our means. The Holy Prophet مال المالة على المالة المال

Huḍūr المعالم also spoke of the manner in which the Promised Messiah and his blessed companions adopted piety and put their trust in God and how God responded with signs of his majesty and love and succour. Ḥuḍūr المعالمة said: Even today these signs are manifested for those who make financial sacrifices for the purpose of spreading the message of the Promised Messiah عليه السام , and also for those who have true sympathy for Islām and are eager to make sacrifices in its cause.

Huḍūr المواللذة said: These experiences are not confined to old Aḥmadīs. New Aḥmadīs, too, are experiencing these wonderful signs. Ḥuḍūr المواللذة related some instances of the blessings experienced by some new African Aḥmadīs after they started making financial sacrifices and how they readily affirmed that these blessings were indeed a result of their sacrifices.

Huḍūr اليواللتان said: Allāh is the true Provider—Rāziq. Whoever puts his trust in Him is never deprived of bounty, for Allāh provides for him in every way wherever he is. Allāh says, when someone puts his faith in Me, I provide for him from heaven and from under his feet. Therefore, we

should put our complete trust in God. The Promised Messiah "says, "Anyone who is in the least cognizant of God's majesty and is mindful of death will be rid of all sloth and indolence. Let us always keep God's majesty in mind and fear Him. His wrath is very severe. Very often He forgives and looks away, but when His retribution comes it is very painful. On the other hand, those who fear God and their hearts are filled with His awe and majesty, He grants them honour and becomes for them like a shield."

Closing the sermon, Ḥuḍūr إِيوَاللَّهُ اللَّهُ prayed: May Allāh have mercy on us all. May He save us from even His slightest displeasure. May He grant us His bounties and provide for us more than we can ever imagine. May He show us signs of His mercy and munificence and establish His awe in our hearts.
