On 16th April 2010, Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ V الموه الله أله delivered the Friday Sermon at Pietro de Castel in Bologna, Italy.

Ḥuḍūr إليوالله said: Today, for the first time, the Friday sermon is being broadcast live from Italy. Our Jamā'at had no centre in this country until Allāh enabled us to buy this place two years ago. May He also enable us to build a mosque here and also in Rome itself. Despite heated opposition, Allāh has enabled the Jamā'at to build mosques in various cities of Europe. This has been possible only due to Allāh's sheer grace.

Ḥuḍūr إلى said: Allāh is providing us with the means to convey the message of Islām to the world. Every Aḥmadī needs to become an ambassador of the Jamā'at and try to attain higher spiritual and moral standards. Become grateful servants of Allāh and the best way of showing your gratitude is by walking the path of *Taqwa*, remembering the purpose of your creation, keeping a watchful eye on your inner selves, putting your faith above everything else, showing the highest examples of mutual love and brotherhood, becoming firmly attached with the Jamā'at and Khilāfat, and establishing the sovereignty of God in your hearts by adhering to the conditions of Bai'at that you have pledged to the Promised Messiah 'المالة المالة على المالة المالة

Huḍūr المواللة said: Allāh is most Gracious and Benign and we have to be infinitely grateful to Him. Of course it is not possible to repay His kindness, and a believer has to spend his whole life showing his gratitude to Him and being His sincere servant. Huḍūr المواللة said: Allāh's acceptance of one's faith is also a bounty for which man should be grateful. One cannot become grateful and be a faithful servant of Allāh without worshipping Him, hence it is important to become regular in our prayers.

Huḍūr المعالية said: The only way to spread Islām in the world is through prayers and only through prayers will our efforts bear fruit. The Promised Messiah عليه السالية says that only our supplications will cause us to prevail. Let us, therefore, pay greater attention to our prayers. We also need to struggle against our baser self and become obedient to God. The Promised Messiah عليه says, "All the internal and external parts of our body and all the faculties we have been granted are meant to seek God and to love and worship Him."

Huḍūr الموالسة said: God has saved you from falling into the infernal abyss by enabling you to accept the Promised Messiah ما عليه and by bringing you under the shelter of Khilāfat. You need to hold on to this chain at all costs. But in order to remain attached to the Jamā'at and to benefit from the blessings of Khilāfat, it is necessary to walk the path of Taqwa, to have firm faith and to do good deeds. To strengthen your faith, you

have to fear God, become virtuous and follow in the footsteps of the Holy Prophet مالي الله عليه وسلى الله على الله

Ḥuḍūr إيوالله said: We should spend every moment of our lives according to the will of God so that when the moment of death comes it finds us striving, with all our ability, to win His pleasure. The Promised Messiah عليه says, "I believe that one cannot have true sympathy for mankind and one's heart cannot become free of rancour unless one also prays for one's enemies." Those who strive in the path of *Taqwa* have to hold fast to this teaching and fulfil their obligations to God and to man.

Ḥuḍūr إليوالله said: It is also a requirement of *Taqwa* that every individual Aḥmadī should cooperate fully with the office bearers with a true spirit of obedience. Likewise, every office-holder should obey and respect those who are above him. May Allāh enable all Ahmadīs and the office-bearers in particular to set high examples. Āmīn.
