On 18th June, 2010, Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ V ایده اللہ تعالیٰ delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

In this Sermon Ḥuḍūr ایده اللہ تعالیٰ spoke about some more of the Aḥmadīs martyred in the Lahore attacks and shed light on their family backgrounds, their services, their devotion to the Jamā'at and their personal qualities. This is a very brief synopsis of Ḥuḍūr's ایده اللہ تعالیٰ sermon.

(23) Malik Abdur Rasheed Ṣāḥib, 64, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was the grandson of Ḥaḍrat Maulawī Mehr Din Ṣāḥib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام.

(24) Muhammad Rasheed Hashmi Ṣāḥib, 78, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was the great grandson of Ḥaḍrat Shah Din Hashmi Ṣāḥib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام.

(25) Muzaffar Ahmad Ṣāḥib, 73, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was the son-in-law of Mian Alam Din Ṣāḥib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام.

(26) Mian Mubashar Ahmad Ṣāḥib, 65, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He belongs to the family of Mian Nuruddin Ṣāḥib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام.

(27) Fida Hussain Ṣāḥib, 69, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He as the cousin of the aforementioned Mian Mubashar Aḥmad Ṣāḥib.

(28) Khawar Ayyub Ṣāḥib, 50, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He accepted Aḥmadiyyat in 1985.

(29) Sheikh Muhammad Yunus Ṣāḥib, 63, was martyred in Baitun Nūr, Model Town. He was the son of Sheikh Jamil Aḥmad, a Darvesh of Qādiān. He also served in Ṣadr Anjuman Aḥmadiyya, Rabwah.

(30) Masood Ahmad Bhatti, 33, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was a contractor and a very active member of Khuddam-ul-Aḥmadiyya.

(31) Haji Muhammad Akram Wirk Ṣāḥib, 74, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He had served as an employee of the government's Auqaf Department.

(32) Mian Laeeq Aḥmad Ṣāḥib, 66, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was an electrician.

(33) Mirza Shabil Munir Şāhib, 19, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He had completed his B.Com and was preparing for BBA. He was a great grandson of Ḥaḍrat Aḥmad Din Şāhib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

(34) Malik Maqsood Aḥmad Şāhib, 80, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was the maternal grandson of Ḥaḍrat Malik Ali Baksh Şāhib, a Companion of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

(35) Chaudhary Muhammad Aḥmad Şāhib, 85, was martyred in Baitun Nūr, Model Town. He had retired from the army.

(36) Ilias Ahmad Aslam Qureshi Şāhib, 76, was martyred in Baitun Nūr. He was the president of Johar Town Jamā'at.

(37) Tahir Mahmood Aḥmad Şāhib, 53, was martyred in Baitun Nūr, Model Town.

(38) Syed Irshad Ali Shah Şāhib, 80, was martyred in Baitun Nūr, Model Town. He was a paternal grandson of Ḥaḍrat Khaseelat Ali Shah Şāhib, and a maternal grandson of Ḥaḍrat Mir Hamid Shah Şāhib Sialkoti, both of whom were Companions of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام.

(39) Nurul Ameen Şāhib, 39, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was serving in Pakistan Navy.

(40) Chaudhary Muhammad Mālik Chaddhar Şāhib, 93, was martyred in Baitun Nūr. He was a farmer.

(41) Sheikh Sajid Naeem Şāhib, 59, was martyred in Baitun Nūr. He had retired as manager from MCB bank.

(42) Syed Laeeq Aḥmad Şāhib, 72, was martyred. He also retired as manager from MCB.

(43) Muhammad Ashraf Bhullar Şāhib, 47, was martyred in Baitun Nūr. He was an uncle to Chaudhary Fateh Muhammad Şāhib, ex-Nā'ib Amīr of Lahore District.

(44) Mubarak Aḥmad Tahir Şāhib, 57, was martyred. He was the son-in-law of the late Maulana Dost Muhammad Şāhib, Historian of the Jamā'at. He was serving as vice-president in National Bank.

(45) Anīs Ahmad Şāhib, 35, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was in the business of computer hardware.

(46) Munawwar Aḥmad Şāhib, 30, was martyred in Dārul Zikr. He was the younger brother of the aforementioned Anīs Aḥmad Şāhib.

(47) Saeed Aḥmad Ṭāhir Şāhib, 37, was martyred in Baitun Nūr. He belonged to *Takht Hazara* in Sargodha.

Ḥuḍūr أيده الله تعالى said that the list would continue in the next Sermon.

Ḥuḍūr أيده الله تعالى also spoke about the sad demise of Dr. Muhammad Arif Şāhib, Waqif-e-Zindagi, of Qādiān and his devotion and services for the Jamā'at. Ḥuḍūr

ايدہ اللہ تعالیٰ led his *Namaz Janazah Ghā'ib* after the Jumu'a along with that of Saeed Aḥmad Ṭāhir Ṣāḥib who was injured in Lahore and later died of his wounds.
