Mr Mirza Mahmood Ahmad (58) was martyred at Baitun Nūr, Model Town. Mr Sheikh Muhammad Akram Athar (66) was martyred at Dārul Zikr. Mr Mirza Mansoor Baig (29); Mr Mian Muḥammad Munir Umar (70), a grandson of Hadrat Khalifatul Masih

were martyred at Baitun Nūr, Model Town. Mr Dr Tariq Bashir (57) was martyred at Dārul Zikr. Mr Arshad Mahmood Butt (48); Mr Muhammad Hussain Malhi (68) were martyred at Baitun Nūr, Model Town. Mr Mirza Muhammad Amin (70) was martyred at Dārul Zikr. Mr Malik Zubair Aḥmad (61) was martyred at Baitun Nūr, Model Town. Mr Chaudhry Muhammad Nawaz (80) was martyred at Dārul Zikr. Mr Shiekh Mubashir Aḥmad (47) was martyred at Baitun Nūr, Model Town.
