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Dear Brother,

السلام علیکم ورحمة اللہ وبرکاتہ

On 15th October, 2010, Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ V ایده اللہ تعالیٰ delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

Ḥuḍūr ایده اللہ تعالیٰ recited verses 2-12 of *Sūrah Al-Mursalāt*, which are translated as follows:

“By those which are sent off gently, then gather speed and blow swiftly; and by those who spread a thorough spreading, and then they make clear distinctions, and by those who deliver the Reminder, absolving themselves of responsibility or by way of warning, verily, that which you are promised must come to pass. So when the stars are made to lose *their* light, and when the heaven is rent asunder, and when the mountains are blown away, and when the Messengers are made to appear at the appointed time” (77:2-12)

Ḥuḍūr ایده اللہ تعالیٰ said: While these verses give us the tidings of the spread of Islām in the whole world, they also foretell about the truth of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام and the progress of his Jamā‘at. These verses also contain prophecies, the fulfilment of some of which we have already witnessed, the fulfilment of others we are witnessing today and the fulfilment of still some others we shall, *Inshaallāh*, witness in future. Signs of Allāh’s support for the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام are being witnessed today just as they were in the time of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام, when his message of piety, purity, high moral standards and *taqwa* was spread with the help Divine signs. After him his message was spread by his Companions رضی اللہ عنہم. Slowly pure hearted people joined the Jamā‘at of the Promised Messiah علیہ السلام and their numbers reached hundreds of thousands in his own lifetime.

Ḥuḍūr ایده اللہ تعالیٰ said: The Promised Messiah علیہ السلام said that some signs of the support which God had promised him would appear after his demise, that is to say, in the time of the Khilāfat or the Second Manifestation. Accordingly, we can see that Allāh has provided us with all the facilities required to spread his message in this age. It is our duty to make the best and proper use of all the modern means of communication and become helpers of the Imam in fulfilling the purpose of his coming.

Ḥuḍūr ایده اللہ تعالیٰ said: In keeping with His promises, Allāh has provided us all the modern means for conveying message of Islam, such as the internet and television. The form that the media has taken today could not have been

imagined a few decades ago. All these new means of communication have provided us with a great vehicle for spreading Allāh's message. Through the internet, the books of the Promised Messiah ﷺ have been spread all over the world, in keeping with Allāh's promise that his message would reach the corners of the earth. It is for us that Allāh has caused these things to be invented. Our object should be to bring them into proper use rather than to waste time on frivolous activities.

Ḥuḍūr ایدہ اللہ تعالیٰ said: All those who are working for MTA, whether directly or indirectly, are part of the system that is working to spread our books and our message of piety and righteousness to the world. It is true that these innovations are also being used to spread much that is evil and mundane, but on the other hand there are members of the Jamā'at of the Promised Messiah ﷺ who are using them to spread God's message.

The Promised Messiah ﷺ says, "Wake up, O you who slumber; get up, O you who are heedless, for the time of a great revolution has come. This is the time to cry, not to sleep. This is the time to supplicate, not to ridicule and deny. Pray that God may give you eyes to see the full extent of the darkness that pervades the world, and to behold the light that has been made available to dispel this darkness."

Ḥuḍūr ﷺ said: May Allāh open people's eyes and enable us to convey His message to the best of our ability. *Āmīn*.
