On 18th March 2011, Ḥaḍrat Khalīfatul Masīḥ V اليروالله تعالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

Ḥuḍūr اليوالثيّان said: Natural disasters in the world make God-fearing people apprehensive lest they too are visited by such calamities and lest their sins invite God's displeasure.

The Promised Messiah (says, "The knowledge I have been given of [future] calamities is that death shall cast its net everywhere. There will be earthquakes of great magnitude, some of which will be the very picture of doomsday. They will turn the earth upside down and embitter the lives of many. God will then have mercy on those who repent and give up sin. No fear and no grief shall come upon those who will reform themselves and adopt the path desirable to God. God has said to me, 'You have come from Me and I have sent you so that the wrongdoers may stand apart from the righteous. I shall bless thee greatly, so much so that kings will seek blessings from thy garments' "The Promised Messiah also says, "A terrible earthquake is destined to come, but the righteous will be saved from it. Moreover many other disasters and calamities shall also visit the earth."

Huḍūr الموالية said: Allāh is showing these signs again and again in different parts of the world. We, therefore, need to heed these warnings by striving to strengthen our faith and endeavouring to convey to the world the message of the Promised Messiah والميالية clearly said that signs in his support would continue to appear even after him. We should convey his message to the world with the same zeal and enthusiasm as he did.

Speaking of the devastation left by the earthquake and tsunami in Japan, Ḥuḍūr ليواللية said: Whole towns and villages were wiped off the face of the earth. This should be a warning for everyone. May Allāh grant the world the good fortune to recognize the truth and the true teaching so that they may be saved. Jamā'at Aḥmadiyya Japan should convey this message as widely as possible and also carry on their humanitarian efforts. The Promised Messiah المياليات himself expressed the desire for his message to be conveyed to the people of Japan.

said: The nations which think that they are safe are not actually safe, and if they do not turn towards God, these calamities could overtake them all. The Promised Messiah عليه says, "God found this world plunged in darkness and heedlessness and bereft of faith and truth and piety and righteousness, so He sent me to re-establish true knowledge, true practice, true morals and true faith." The Promised Messiah علياليات also says, "I have frequently been given news of coming earthquakes. Just as earthquakes have struck America and Europe in keeping with my prophecies, so shall they strike different parts of Asia." He further said, "O Europe, you are not secure and O Asia you, too, are not secure and O inhabitants of islands, no artificial God will save you. I see cities in ruins and I find habitations desolate. I say truly that the turn of this country is drawing nearer. You will witness with your own eves the time of Noah and experience firsthand the episode of the people of Lot. But God is slow in wrath; repent, therefore, so that He may have said: Let us pray that people may be able to realize this and Allāh may grant them understanding.

At the end of the Sermon, Ḥuḍūr اليواشتالي informed the Jamā'at of the tragic martyrdom of Rana Zafrullah Ṣāḥib, son of Muhammad Sharif Sahib of Sanghar. He was the Qaid of Majlis Khuddāmul Aḥmadiyya and Secretary Māl of Jamā'at Aḥmadiyya Sanghar. Ḥuḍūr اليواشتالي led his Namāz Janāzah Ghā'ib after the Jumu'a prayer.
