On 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2012, Hadrat Khalīfatul Masīh V اليواللي delivered the Friday Sermon at Bai'atul Wahid Mosque, Feltham.

After reciting verse 19 of Sūrah *Al-Jinn* and verse 30 of Sūrah *Al-A'raf*, which are translated as follows:

"And all places of worship belong to Allāh; so call not on any one beside Allāh." (72:19)

"Say, 'My Lord has enjoined justice.' And fix your attention aright at every *time and* place of worship, and call upon Him, making yourselves sincere towards Him in religion. As He brought you into being, so shall you return." (7:30)

Hudur اليوه الشقائ said: Today, by the grace of Allāh, we are opening a new mosque in this area of Feltham and Hounslow. May Allāh make our mosques the means of spreading the message of Islām, may He open for us new avenues to convey to the people the true and beautiful teachings of our religion, and may these mosques become the means of fostering our faith.

Hudur אַפּוּשׁיּשׁלּי said: The verses I have recited speak of the importance of mosques. Mosques are built solely for the remembrance of Allāh and one should enter them in humility and submission. All people are free to worship in a mosque, but idolatry can never be allowed in this holy place. Tauhid, or God's Oneness, can only spread through the teachings of the Holy Prophet של מול and through the mosques. Our duty is to become more devout in our worship, establish a living relationship with God and strive to spread the light of truth all over the world.

Hudur 'said: Allāh commands us to establish justice and equity, to fulfil our obligations, to rise above every kind of partiality and bigotry, and to walk the path of righteousness. Only those who are pure of heart can be expected to do full justice to God's worship. And this is only possible if we abide by God's commandments. We must remember that all our actions in this world will merit reward or punishment in the hereafter. We must keep watch over our actions and safeguard our souls for the sake of the next world. The Promised Messiah (says that we must remember God with sincerity and recognize His favours. Our inclination to God should be such that he alone should be our Helper and Sustainer.

Hudur اليوالشرتعالى said: A true believer is one who is ever ready to cooperate in good things and is disinclined to vice and sin. The beauty of our Jama'at is that we vie with one another in doing good deeds. Hudur المعادة said: One of the reasons for congregation in the mosques is to become like one body and to foster mutual love and sympathy. The Promised Messiah المعادة has urged us to help our weaker brothers and strengthen them. No Jama'at is worth its name unless the strong among them support the weak.

Budur اليوالشقال said: The Promised Messiah اليوالشقال came to re-establish Taqwa in the world and to create a Jama'at of people who are God's true servants. Having built this mosque, our greatest joy will consist in devoting ourselves to our faith. Hudur اليوالشقال spoke about the zeal and spiritual fervour of some new Ahmadīs and said: In this age it is through the Promised Messiah الميوالسان that people are learning about the true teachings of Islām. Hudur اليوالشقال gave some details about the construction of the mosque and prayed for all those who made sacrifices for it. Hudur اليوالشقال said: The real purpose of a mosque is that it should be populated with worshippers. May Allāh enable us to do so. Āmīn.

At the end of the Sermon, Hudur שֵׁמִישׁׁ appealed to the Jama'at to pray for Ahmadīs who are facing difficulties and persecution in various parts of the world. May Allāh safeguard Ahmadīs against every mischief.  $\bar{A}m\bar{\imath}n$ .
