On 16th November 2012, Hadrat Khalifatul Masih V ليوه الله قالى delivered the Friday Sermon at Baitul Futuh Mosque, London.

In this sermon Hudur ايره الله تعالى spoke about the sad demise of a Ghanian Ahmadiyya Missionary, Hafiz Ahmad Jibreel Saeed Sahib. Hudur ايره الله تعالى spoke in detail about his services for the Jama'at.

After receiving education at Madrasa-tul-Hifz and Jāmi'a Ahmadiyya, Rabwah, he served in various countries of Africa and Pacific Islands. He was a devoted servant of the Jama'at who dutifully fulfilled his pledge of Waqf and served as *Sultan-e-Naseer* for the Khalifatul Masih. He was a pillar of Jama'at Ahmadiyya Ghana and brought it many distinctions.

Hafiz Ahmad Jibreel Saeed was born in 1954. By the grace of Allāh he was the first Ghanian to have committed the Holy Qur'ān to memory. Along with graduating from Jāmi'a Ahmadiyya Rabwah in 1982 he also passed the Honours in Arabic examination. He was formally appointed as the Jama'at's first missionary to Tuvalu. He planted the seed of the Jama'at in Marshall Island, Solomon Island and Micronesia. Thereafter he went to Kiribati as its first missionary and spread the message of Ahmadiyyat in the South Pacific Islands for 8 years. In 1994 he returned to Ghana and was appointed as the Nā'ib Amīr for Da'wat Ilallāh and served in this capacity to the end. As a result of his efforts thousands of people were converted to Ahmadiyyat and many new mosques were built. From 2001-2003 he was again sent to tour the South Pacific Islands. Again in 2010, I sent him there to reorganize the Jama'at. He came back with very fruitful and tangible results.

Hudur اليوالثرة said: Hafiz Sahib loved Da'wat Ilallāh. He was a very patient and resolute person. He treated his subordinates with great kindness. He had a wide circle of acquaintances and kept good relations with both the rich and the poor. He was full of concern for the Jama'at and with the zeal to serve. He was very obedient and hard-working and had great respect for his teachers. He was a learned person and an expert in Kiribati. He also translated the Holy Qur'ān in that language.

Hudur اليه الله also informed the Jama'at of the tragic martyrdom of Manzoor Ahmad Sahib son of Nawab Khan Sahib of Quetta, Pakistan and spoke about his services for the Jama'at.

At the end of the sermon, Hudur اليوه الشتعالي appealed to all Ahmadīs to pray for Ahmadīs in Pakistan and urged members to concentrate on offering *Durud* during the days of *Muharram*.
