On 30 May 2014, Hadrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper) delivered the Friday Sermon at the Baitul Futūh Mosque, Morden, London.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: It is a great blessing of God Almighty that He has made the entire Jamā‘at one unit. The history of Jamā‘at Ahmadiyya’s previous 106 years is testament to the fact that after the demise of the Promised Messiah عليه السلام, members of the Jamā‘at pledged allegiance to the institution of Khilāfat submitting themselves to it completely. Ahmadīs around the world are aware that showing full submission to the institution of Khilāfat, which was destined to follow the Promised Messiah عليه السلام, is their greatest responsibility.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: The ones who adhere to Khilāfat have been decreed to be the heirs of great blessings because they pay attention to worshipping God, offering sacrifices before Him, and striving for His Unity to be established on earth.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Every time we celebrate the Khilāfat Day, we ought to focus on Prayer, acts of worship and Unity of God Almighty, and this should help us analyse ourselves as to how much effort we have made towards the establishment of Divine Unity in the world. If the standard of our relationship with God is not improving, mere gatherings, speeches, scholarly discussions and celebrations are of no avail whatsoever.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: In times of hardship and distress, we should bow down before God Almighty. We should try to receive Divine blessings by offering supplications to Him and by paying utmost attention to Prayer and *Istighfar*. We need constant prayers to alleviate our worries and to successfully handle the victories God is going to grant us.

Drawing the attention of members of the Jamā‘at towards certain prayers, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: We should not be neglectful of the prayers prescribed for the Jamā‘at on the occasion of the Centenary Khilāfat celebrations; rather we should continue to recite them.

The first prayer is the recitation of Sūrah Fatiha which should be followed by the Durud. Then we should recite the following prayers:

1. سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ وَبِحَمْدِهِ سُبْحَانَ اللَّهِ الْعَظِيمِ. اَللّٰهُمَّ صَلِّ عَلٰى مُحَمَّدٍ وَ اٰلِ مُحَمَّدٍ

2. رَبَّنَا لَا تُرِغْ قُلُوبَنَا بَعْدَ إِذْ هَدَيْتَنَا وَهَبْ لَنَا مِنْ لَدُنْكَ رَحْمَةً إِنَّكَ أَنْتَ الْوَهَّابُ (3:9) •
3. رَبَّنَا أَفْرِغْ عَلَيْنَا صَبْرًا وَثَبِّتْ أَقْدَامَنَا وَانصُرْنَا عَلَى الْقَوْمِ الْكَافِرِينَ •
4. اللَّهُمَّ إِنَّا نَجْعَلُكَ فِي نُحُورِهِمْ وَنَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْ شُرُورِهِمْ •
5. أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ رَبِّي مِنْ كُلِّ ذَنْبٍ وَأَتُوبُ إِلَيْهِ •
6. رَبِّ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ خَادِمٌ رَبِّ فَاحْفَظْنِي وَانصُرْنِي وَإِمْحَمْنِي •
7. رَبَّنَا اغْفِرْ لَنَا ذُنُوبَنَا وَإِسْرَافَنَا فِي أَمْرِنَا وَثَبِّتْ أَقْدَامَنَا وَانصُرْنَا عَلَى الْقَوْمِ الْكَافِرِينَ (3:148)

Indeed, these prayers should be recited quite often.

Next, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) spoke of the martyrdom of Dr. Mahdī Ali Qamar Sahib son of Chaudhry Farzand Ali Sahib of Rabwah, Pakistan, who was a sincere and faithful Ahmadī and a compassionate and loving person. By profession, he was a cardiologist and was working in the United States of America.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) gave details of Dr Mahdī Ali Qamar Sahib's martyrdom along with his detailed introduction, and also related the statements of his relatives about him.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also mentioned the media coverage given to the martyrdom.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Dr Mahdī Ali Qamar Sahib was a very warm-hearted person with a kind disposition. He was good to everyone and sympathized with people in need. He was a very humble person who was also kind, loving and compassionate towards his wife and children. He was sincerely devoted to Khilāfat, and responded to every call of Khalīfatul-Masīh for every sacrifice, and was eager to give the Chanda on time. He was a keen *Da'i Ilallāh* [one who invited others to God] and passionately spread the message of Islam to people he met.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Dr Mahdī Ali Qamar Sahib was a good poet also. Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) graciously quoted some of the Urdu verses Dr Mahdi Ali Qamar Sahib had composed.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Newspapers in Pakistan, USA, Canada, Britain and other parts of the world have condemned the brutal murder of Dr Mahdi Ali Qamar Sahib. More than 30 reputed newspapers have covered the incident giving details of the martyrdom as well providing information to the public about the Jamā‘at and its history.

Towards the end of the Friday Sermon, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) urged the Ahmadīs around the world to pray for their Pakistani brothers and announced that after the Jumu‘a he will lead the funeral prayer in absentia of Dr Mahdī Ali Qamar Sahib.
