The Amīr/National President Jamā'at Ahmadiyya,

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Dear Brother,

On 20th June 2014, Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper) delivered the Friday Sermon at the Baitul Futūh Mosque, London.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) spoke about the loyalty, obedience and sincerity that members of the Jamā'at have for the institution of Khilāfat in the Jamā'at and prayed that may Allah increase all Ahmadīs in sincerity and obedience to Khilāfat.

Speaking about the Jalsa Sālāna of Jamā'at Germany, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Our gatherings are not only graced by members of the Jamā'at, but rather by people who do not belong to the Jamā'at and by members of other faiths as well. They attend our Jalsas and observe our actions and the example we set for them. When they listen to and watch the programmes of the Jalsa in a spiritually rich environment, some of them pledge their allegiance to Ahmadiyyat before even returning home. In short, the Jalsa has a very positive and spiritual effect on members of the Jamā'at and the guests both.

Speaking about his recent visit to Germany, Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: During this trip, I had the opportunity to lay down foundation stone of some mosques and also to inaugurate a few. I took the opportunity to spread the beautiful teachings of Islām and the message of Ahmadiyyat to people of other faiths. A number of newspapers also covered these programmes due to which the message of Ahmadiyyat and the true Islam reached millions of people around the world.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: Apart from Ahmadīs, delegations of non-Ahmadī guests from neighbouring countries also took part in the Jalsa.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) related the positive comments made by some non-Ahmadī guests at the Jalsa.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: The guests appreciated and praised the arrangements for the Jalsa, its spiritual environment, and the speeches by Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh as well as the opportunity of meeting with Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) in person.

The guests said that all their suspicions and fears about Islam had been put to rest after listening to Huzoor's (May Allāh be his Helper) speeches and meeting with him in person. An Albanian guest said that a prominent feature seen in this year's Jalsa was the extraordinary attendance of the native German Ahmadīs. He said that people of all other

faiths use mere words to propagate their religion, whereas members of the Ahmadiyya Jamā'at are unique in being the true example of Islām. They not only preach the message of Islām by their tongues, but also act upon the beautiful teachings of Islām.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: A guest from Hungary said that the harmony and unity witnessed among the members of the Jamā'at is evident to everyone and that Ahmadīs have surpassed all others in compassion and humanitarian work.

The ceremony of Bai'at was a fascinating and captivating experience for many non-Ahmadī guests of the Jalsa. The guests said that members of the Ahmadiyya Jamā'at have true love for their Khalīfa and that this love feels pure and selfless because it is not affected or fabricated. Doubtless, to organize such an extraordinary event where there is peace, love, and tolerance for everyone is unique to the Ahmadiyya Jamā'at.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: On the third day of the Jalsa, 83 people from 19 nations took Bai'at and thus joined Ahmadiyyat.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also related few faith- inspiring incidents from the lives of the people who took Bai'at during the Jalsa.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: All who attended the Jalsa had good impressions about it. The press and media also covered the event. More than 60 reports about the inauguration of the mosques and the Jalsa were broadcast on various television channels. Moreover, news about the Jalsa and the mosques was printed in various newspapers and 4 radio channels broadcast the news of the event. The Jamā'at Germany has estimated that due to the Jalsa, the message of Ahmadiyyat reached about as many as 37 million people. Indeed, this was possible only by Allāh's grace and help.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: As we should be thankful to God Almighty for His blessings and grace that He has bestowed upon us, we should also keep in mind our shortcomings and flaws and try to improve the arrangements every year.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) pointed out the fault in the sound system at the Jalsa and mentioned certain complaints regarding the quality of the bread provided to the guests during the Jalsa.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) instructed that such complaints should be properly noted down in the Red Book, so that the arrangements for the Jalsa keep improving every year.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: The office bearers of the Jamā'at need to shun their egos and consider themselves to be humble workers and servants of the Jamā'at. They should attribute the successes of Jamā'at to Allāh's blessings and not to their own efforts and should strive to progress in humility, meekness and thankfulness to Allah. May Allāh instil this spirit of selflessness in all the office bearers of the Jamā'at at every level and make us worthy of receiving His blessings much more than before. $\bar{A}m\bar{\nu}n$
