On 5 September 2014, Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (May Allāh be his Helper) delivered the Friday Sermon at the Baitul Futūh Mosque, Morden, London.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: By the grace of Allāh the UK Jalsa Sālāna took place successfully last week with its blessings spreading across the world. Everyone, without exception, wrote that the arrangements of the Jalsa were much better and improved than the previous years and that the speeches made during the Jalsa were also of a higher scholarly and spiritual standard.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) spoke of the Divine blessings and grace that helped the organizers of the Jalsa do their duties well and cited impressions of certain guests of the Jalsa. Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) thanked all the volunteer workers and also mentioned a few deficiencies.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: With the grace of Allah, the atmosphere of Jalsa Sālāna affects each pious-natured soul. Some become so impressed and affected that they end up taking *Bai‘at*. Some guests observed that they witnessed such practices of unity, love and affection at the Jalsa which the Holy Prophet ﷺ wished for his *Ummah*. The guests said that the Jalsa organisation was excellent and that they were extremely impressed by the discipline, sense of sincerity and unity of the Jamā‘at. The guests also appreciated the Jalsa volunteer workers saying they did their duties exhibiting exemplary standards of morality. Some guests commented that by attending the Jalsa they have begun to pay more attention towards Islāmic teachings, and that the atmosphere at the Jalsa made them think more positively about Islām. The guests commended the speeches made by me saying they were meant for the whole mankind and without any discrimination against anyone. The guests said that the participants of the Jalsa met each other as if they were already well-introduced to each other. Everyone greeted each other by saying ‘Salam’. Indeed, this is the true Islām. The guests praised the arrangements of the Jalsa and said that they never witnessed such perfection of organization, peace and harmony anywhere else. Some guests praised the efforts of the Jamā‘at for peace in the world and said that it is the Ahmadiyya Community alone that is truly sincerely and patiently working towards peace in the world, and that they were pleased that the Ahmadiyya Jamā‘at not only preaches peace but also demonstrates it through its actions. The guests also commended the humanitarian work being done by the Humanity First throughout the world. Some guests said that the Jalsa organisation was tremendous and one could sense that God’s hand was behind the Jamā‘at.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also quoted some new Ahmadīs who expressed their views about the Jalsa. Some of them said that the Jalsa made them realize how widely the Ahmadiyya Jamā‘at has spread in the world. Some said that the organization of the Jalsa was

so perfect that it seemed as if a magician had placed everything perfectly in place. The guests also praised the hospitality of the Jalsa volunteers saying they demonstrated the true spirit of 'Love for All – Hatred for None'. Some guests commented that they found Ahmadīs from all over the world, who came from different countries and backgrounds, to be filled with the love of their Khalīfa. This was something they felt was extraordinary. The speeches made by me were also deeply applauded by the Jalsa guests who said that they were not only scholarly but also had a soothing effect on the hearts of the people. Everyone who attended the Jalsa testified that Islām is the religion of peace and love, which is needed by every person in this world. Indeed, the Jalsa had a miraculous effect on the lives of the participants.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) spoke of the MTA volunteer workers and praised their efforts for a smooth transmission of the Jalsa across the globe. Not only Ahmadīs lauded the MTA workers and their efforts but also many non-Ahmadī guests praised the staff of the channel for their hard work. Response of Ahmadī and non-Ahmadī Arabs has been very good. MTA broadcasts were shown live for a number of hours on all the three days of the Jalsa on the national channels of Ghana and Sierra Leone and on a private channel in Nigeria and were very well-received. About 330,000 people watched Jalsa through live streaming on the internet; this is in addition to viewing on MTA.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also mentioned a few deficiencies of the volunteer workers at the Jalsa and reminded the organizers to note them down in the *Red Book*, so that the mistakes are not repeated again and so that the arrangements can be improved in the future.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said that he too would like to thank the volunteer workers of the Jalsa just as numerous other guests had done.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) also thanked the female volunteer workers of the Jalsa for their cooperation for the various arrangements of the Jalsa.

Huzoor (May Allāh be his Helper) said: May Allah give the best reward to all the volunteer workers of the Jalsa for their sincerity and services for the Jamā'at and the guests of the Jalsa.
