



## BEACON OF MERCY IN WALES: HUZOOR INAUGURATES BAITUR RAHEEM MOSQUE IN CARDIFF

---



On Sunday, 23 November 2025, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamaat in the United Kingdom witnessed a historic milestone as Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad, Khalifatul Masih Vaa, inaugurated the Baitur Raheem Mosque in Cardiff. This marks the first purpose-built mosque of the Jamaat in Wales.

Just before 17:00 GMT, Huzooraa arrived at the site. Upon arrival, he unveiled the commemorative plaque, planted a commemorative sapling in the mosque grounds and led a silent prayer to mark the inauguration. Shortly after, Huzooraa led the Maghrib and Isha prayers in the new mosque. Huzooraa also graciously met with various dignitaries, followed by various group photographs with Jamaat members.

### The inauguration reception

The formal reception to celebrate the opening began shortly after 18:00 in a marquee erected on the mosque premises.

The proceedings commenced with the recitation of verses 128–130 of Surah al-Baqarah from the Holy Quran, followed by its English translation.

The Regional Amir of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamaat gave a welcome address, expressing gratitude to Huzooraa for gracing the occasion. This was followed by brief remarks from several guest dignitaries who congratulated the Jamaat on this achievement.

The speakers included the High Sheriff Janet Davies and the High Sheriff of Gwent, Lieutenant Colonel Ralph Griffin. A video message was played from the Rt Hon Jo Stevens MP, Secretary of State for Wales, who sent her felicitations. Jane Elizabeth Hutt CBE, Cabinet Secretary for Social Justice (Wales), also addressed the gathering, acknowledging the Jamaat's contributions to society.

## **Keynote address by Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V<sup>aa</sup>**

Just before 18:30, Hazrat Amirul Momineen<sup>aa</sup> took to the podium to deliver the keynote address. After reciting tashahhud, ta’awwudh and bismillah, Huzooraa conveyed his salaam to all attendees.

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> began by thanking the guests for accepting the invitation, stating that their attendance at a “purely religious and spiritual event” demonstrated their “open hearts and generosity of spirit.”

### **The purpose of a mosque**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> explained that the primary purpose of this mosque, like all true mosques, was to serve as a sacred place for the worship of Allah. However, he emphasised that a mosque also stands as a testament to the Jamaat’s commitment to its neighbours and the local community.

“Indeed, the abiding message that echoes aloud from all our mosques is that where they serve as a place to worship Allah, they also serve to foster peace, compassion and harmony throughout the world,” Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> stated.

Addressing potential misconceptions about Islam, Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> reassured the local community that our mosques always stand as “shining beacons of peace, love, and harmony.” He referenced an incident from the life of the Holy Prophet<sup>sa</sup> where a mosque built with malicious intent to create disorder (known as Masjid Dirar) was ordered to be demolished by Allah the Almighty. Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> explained that a physical structure only fulfils the purpose of a mosque when used to manifest Islam’s true teachings of kindness and to spread peace.

### **Rights of mankind and true worship**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> affirmed that the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community has always stood at the forefront of striving for peace, upholding the rights of all people regardless of faith. He explained that this conduct is not a deviation from Islam but adherence to it.

Quoting chapter 107 of the Holy Quran, Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> highlighted that Allah rejects the prayers of those who disregard the rights of the vulnerable, such as orphans and those mired in poverty. He stated, “Allah the Almighty explicitly states that prayers and worship shall only be of value and accepted when aligned with service to humanity.”

Referring to chapter 90, verse 11, Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> noted that Allah has pointed out the “two highways of good and evil”, granting humans the moral compass to discern right from wrong. “However, if a person ignores their internal compass and follows selfish and worldly desires, they are bound to deviate from the right path and embrace evil and wrongdoing,” Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> explained.

## **Ending slavery and exploitation**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> elaborated on verse 14 of chapter 90, which categorises freeing an enslaved person as a high form of worship. He noted that while the Holy Prophet<sup>sa</sup> liberated slaves and ended physical slavery as “Islam came to end all forms of slavery in the world”, a form of “economic servitude” persists today. “Less developed nations are trapped by crippling debt,” Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> observed, noting that vulnerable nations are often dictated to by wealthier ones. He stated that Islam condemns such exploitation, as inequalities and injustices inevitably shatter the foundations of global peace.

## **Helping the vulnerable**

Continuing with the themes of chapter 90, Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> spoke on the virtue of feeding the hungry and supporting the impoverished. He drew specific attention to the Quranic instruction to help “a poor man lying in the dust.” Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> explained, “These words are deeply significant, meaning Muslims are obligated to help those who are utterly crestfallen, who have no one else to aid them and who have been forgotten by society. While some people have family and friends to support them, Muslims are instructed to identify and to help those who have no one else. In economic terms, it means that if an individual has hit rock bottom and has no one to help them, a Muslim must endeavour to assist them and help them get back on their feet.”

He invited all people to join the Community in this mission of establishing peace and goodwill, stating, “Imagine the impact if all the nations of the world, including every Muslim country, acted upon this unifying and magnanimous principle. Surely, it would be the means of tearing down the walls of crippling inequality, injustice, and ignorance that plague the world. And in their place, we would witness the majestic sight of rising tides of love, compassion, and understanding sweeping across society; true contentment, peace, and security would prevail.”

## **A comprehensive code of moral values**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> then quoted chapter 4, verse 37 of the Holy Quran, describing it as a comprehensive code of moral duties. This verse commands Muslims to worship Allah alone while simultaneously showing kindness to parents, kindred, orphans, the needy, neighbours, travel companions and subordinates.

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> said, "In terms of human rights, the verse firstly calls on Muslims to treat their parents with tenderness and affection. Neglecting one's parents weakens the family unit whilst increasing the strain on the wider community. So, Allah says that caring for others should start from one's home. Then, Allah says, Muslims must care for their relatives and friends and fulfil their rights."

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> emphasised that the Quran requires Muslims to show kindness even to "the neighbour that is a stranger", which includes those living further afield as well as work colleagues.

Regarding travel companions, he noted that on public transport, Muslims must show courtesy and protection to fellow passengers.

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> said, "Muslims must care for their subordinates, or those under their duty of care. Those in a position of power should never wield their authority harshly or needlessly, as Allah dislikes arrogance or pride."

## **Loyalty and obedience**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> reiterated that the Holy Quran instructs Muslims to respect leaders and uphold the laws of the land, making loyalty to one's country an intrinsic element of faith.

"Consequently, those who possess even a basic attachment to Islam understand that pleasing God and fulfilling a mosque's objectives are inseparable from adopting the highest moral values and serving humanity," he said.

## **Practising what is preached**

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> clarified that the Community does not merely make claims to impress others but is determined to act on its teachings. He highlighted the Community's humanitarian efforts, including hospitals, schools and water projects in the developing world that serve people irrespective of religion.

Speaking on the value of water, Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> noted that in the West, it is difficult to appreciate the struggle of children in deprived countries who walk miles daily to fetch clean drinking water. He explained that the Community sends engineers to provide water at people's doorsteps to break the cycle of poverty.

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> said, "In terms of education, we have established hundreds of schools across the developing nations that provide primary and secondary education without any distinction. It matters not whether the students in our classrooms are Christians, Jews, Muslims, atheists, or followers of any other belief. Every child is of immeasurable worth and value, and so, with the grace of Allah, the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community is constantly engaged in serving humanity, and this includes supporting local charities and community projects across the United Kingdom. Our sole aspiration and motivation is to alleviate suffering and to enable people to live their lives with dignity."

## **Conclusion**

Concluding his address, Huzooraa reminded the local Ahmadi Muslims of their responsibilities:

"I also wish to remind all Ahmadi Muslims living in this area that they must strive to live according to the inclusive and noble teachings of Islam that I have outlined today. While it is their duty to worship Allah in this mosque and pray for peace, it is equally their obligation to strive towards achieving it and to be ready to make sacrifices for the greater good of mankind. They must consider how they can play a practical role in bringing peace to the world."

Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> prayed, "Now that this mosque is open, it is my heartfelt prayer that those who enter it will fulfil not only the requirements of worshipping Allah but also all needs of humanity."

The event concluded with a silent prayer led by Huzoor<sup>aa</sup>, followed by dinner.

## About Baitur Raheem Mosque



The inauguration of the Baitur Raheem Mosque (House of the Merciful) represents the culmination of a long journey for the Ahmadiyya Muslim Jamaat in Wales. The history of the Jamaat in this region dates back to the early 20th century, with early converts such as Mrs Mabel Emma Ali (Safia) accepting Ahmadiyyat in Cardiff in 1920.

The specific need for a mosque in Wales was formally raised in 2011 by the Cardiff chapter of Majlis Ansarullah. Following approval from Hazrat Khalifatul Masih V<sup>aa</sup>, the project was assigned to Majlis Ansarullah UK. After an extensive search, an office building in the Canton area of Cardiff was purchased in 2015. Canton is an inner-city district and community in the west of Cardiff, the capital of Wales, lying just 2 miles west of the city's civic centre.

The project faced significant hurdles, with planning permission initially rejected twice by the local council due to opposition. However, following a successful appeal process and negotiations, full planning approval was granted in 2018. Huzoor<sup>aa</sup> graciously named the mosque "Baitur Raheem."

The foundation stone was laid on 9 September 2023 by Rafiq Ahmed Hayat Sahib, Amir Jamaat-e-Ahmadiyya UK, using a brick prayed upon by Hazrat Amirul Momineen<sup>aa</sup>. Construction formally commenced in 2024 and was completed in 2025. The project was funded entirely by the sacrifices of the members of Majlis Ansarullah UK. This marks the second mosque being built by Majlis Ansarullah UK, with the first being erected in Hartlepool in 2005. The two-storey complex, built on a 1,200-square-metre site, comprises two halls, including a main prayer hall of 170 square metres with a capacity of 270 worshippers.

## WAQF-E-JADID PROGRAM 2025-2027

In the Friday sermon of January 3th, 2025, Huzoor(aba) spoke about Waqf-e-Jadid.

“His Holiness (aba) said that the spending of wealth in the way of Allah is an act of great virtue. Seeing as man has a great attachment to wealth, God has deemed those who spend out of that which they love, i.e. their wealth, attain the pleasure and nearness of Allah because the true sacrifice is spending out of that which one loves.”

### AIMS OF WAQF-E-JADID

- Propagation of the teachings of Islam
- Training and upkeep of mu’alleemeen (teachers) around the world
- Education and moral training of Ahmadis in rural communities
- Publication of literature
- Publication of the Holy Qur’an
- Construction of mosques and mission houses
- Establishment of schools
- Establishment of radio stations in various countries to broadcast teachings of Islam
- Establishment of hospitals
- Other humanitarian works

### SIGNIFICANCE OF WAQF-E-JADID

About this scheme, Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih IIrz said in his Friday Sermon of January 5, 1958:

“This is the undertaking of Allah, and He Himself will complete it. Since it is Allah Almighty who has put this inspiration in my heart, I shall endeavor to fulfill it even if I have to sell my house and my clothes to do so and even if not a single person assists me. Allah shall cut them off from the Jama’at who are not helping me in this regard and will send down angels from heaven to help me.”

### WAQF-E-JADID YEAR

The year is from January 1st to December 31st

### LAJNA IMA’ILLAH GOALS

- Our goal is 100% participation as well as an increase in contribution.
- All Lajna and Nasirat are to be encouraged to contribute to this scheme no matter how nominal it may be.
- Those who are already contributing are to be encouraged to increase their level of sacrifice even if by a small percentage.
- US Lajna should contribute  $\frac{1}{3}$  of all the funds raised by the US Jamaat.
- Special emphasis is to be laid on including new Ahmadis in the Waqf-e-Jadid system. Huzoor(aba) stated in his Friday sermon of January 9, 2015: “Strong connections are made when new Ahmadis are included in the financial giving system. Along with the development of faith it also builds strong connections with the administration of Jama’at.”

### NANHI MUJAHID (LITTLE STRIVER/WARRIOR) OF WAQF-E-JADID

Encourage all Nasirat to become Nanhi Mujahid by sacrificing \$50 or more of their own money toward the blessed Waqf-e-Jadid Scheme. This money may be earned, and it may be received from parents for performing certain tasks around the house. Our ultimate goal is to have the US Ahmadi children contribute half of all Waqf-e-Jadid collection, InshAllah. Children (under the age of 7) may be included at the request of parents.

### CREATE LOVE FOR WAQF-E-JADID IN CHILDREN

Huzoor(aba) said, in his Friday sermon of January 4, 2008:

“Hadhrat Khalifatul Masih III(ra) promoted Waqf-e-Jadid particularly among children and, through the blessings of this scheme, half of the contributions from Pakistan are from children. It is most gratifying that our community has children with such spirit; they are indeed an assurance of the blessings to come in the generation to come.” Huzoor urged parents worldwide to focus on this. He asked the Waqf-e-Jadid secretaries, the Nasirat and Ajal secretaries to also take note. Awareness of the blessing of Waqf-e-Jadid should be raised among children. Those who will grow up with this awareness in this materialistic world will not only become an asset for the Community, but their personal lives will also be rewarded by Allah due to this.

## NASIRAT-UL-AHMADIYYA

Huzoor(aba) has instructed that, "At least twenty percent of the target given to Lajna should be borne by Nasirat-ul-Ahmadiyya." Toward this goal, Waqf-e-Jadid collection targets will be assigned for Nasirat.

### IDEAS FOR NASIRAT TO RAISE FUNDS FOR WAQF-E-JADID

- They could be encouraged to earn money by doing chores around their own homes.
- Snacks and/or handicrafts could be prepared and sold at the local mosque.
- Huzoor(aba) advised that children should save the money they might otherwise spend on buying fast food, so that they can give more to Waqf-e-Jadid.
- Each Nasira could be paired with, and mentored by, a Lajna member to meet her goals.

### WAQF-E-JADID DAY

Please hold a Waqf-e-Jadid Day during the months of April, August and December. This may be held as part of a Lajna or Nasirat meeting with the intention to motivate the Lajna and Nasirat to participate in this blessed scheme and to inform the members of the needs of the Community; and to make certain that the message is conveyed to EVERYONE. ## FINANCIAL SACRIFICE AND TRUE RIGHTEOUSNESS : WAQFE JADID 2026

---

### **'Spending Out of One's Pure Wealth & Announcement of New Waqf-e-Jadid Year'**

After reciting Tashahhud, Ta'awwuz, and Surah al-Fatihah, His Holiness, Hazrat Mirza Masroor Ahmad(aba) recited the following verse of the Holy Qur'an:

**'Never shall you attain to righteousness unless you spend out of that which you love; and whatever you spend, Allah surely knows it well.'**  
**(The Holy Qur'an, 3:93)**

### **A Means of Attaining Righteousness**

His Holiness(aba) said that in explanation of this verse, the First Caliph of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community explained that here, 'out of that which you love' refers to wealth. Similarly, the Second Caliph of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community explained that one cannot attain to righteousness by spending that which they do not care about. It is only when a person spends out of that which is dear to them that they can truly attain righteousness.

His Holiness(aba) said that those who make good earnings but do not meet the basic standard of financial sacrifice should reflect upon the fact that God has guided that it is only upon spending that which one loves that they can attain the love of God. God has mentioned spending in the way of Allah at various occasions in the Holy Qur'an. For example,

**'And spend for the cause of Allah, and cast not yourselves into ruin with your own hands, and do good; surely, Allah loves those who do good.'**  
**(The Holy Qur'an, 2:196)**

His Holiness(aba) said that not spending in the way of Allah can also lead to a person's ruin. Having accepted the Promised Messiah(as), it cannot be that we have reservations in spending our wealth for the sake of Allah. It is the grace of Allah that the majority of the Community happily spends in the way of Allah. However, a few hesitate to do so. Such people must remember that spending in the way of Allah is necessary to attain His love. There are also those who participate in financial appeals but do not make the regular contributions they should, in accordance with their true income.

## **Miserliness Takes One Away from Allah**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that at another instance in the Holy Qur'an it is stated,

**'Believe in Allah and His Messenger, and spend in the way of Allah out of that to which He has made you heirs. And those of you who believe and spend will have a great reward.' (The Holy Qur'an, 57:8)**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that at another instance, God says in the Holy Qur'an,

**'And why is it that you spend not in the way of Allah, while to Allah belongs the heritage of the heavens and the earth?' (The Holy Qur'an, 57:11)**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that no matter the wealth one has, it will not remain with them when they die; rather, it all remains with Allah. Hence, when the opportunity is there, one should spend that wealth in the way of Allah. At another instance, God says in the Holy Qur'an,

**'So fear Allah as best you can, and listen, and obey, and spend in His cause; it will be good for yourselves. And whoso is rid of the covetousness of his own soul – it is such who shall be successful.' (The Holy Qur'an, 64:17)**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that spending in the way of Allah, not miserliness, will lead to attaining his pleasure and nearness. In this era, as explained by the Promised Messiah<sup>(as)</sup>, finances are naturally required for spreading the true message of Islam. Those who spend for the sake of the faith benefit not just themselves but the entire nation. Hence, for the sake of humanity at large, it is necessary that one spend for the sake of the faith.

## **Allah Returns Our Wealth in Full**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that it is recorded in a narration that God told the Holy Prophet<sup>(sa)</sup> that one should gather their wealth with God, as there is no fear of it being burned or drowned, nor can it be stolen. Wealth given to Allah will be returned in full when a person needs it. It is stated in the Holy Qur'an,

**'And whatever of wealth you spend, it shall be paid back to you in full and you shall not be wronged.' (The Holy Qur'an, 2:273)**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that most Ahmadis understand this concept and spend openly in the way of Allah. Seeing such examples in his Community, the Promised Messiah<sup>(as)</sup> expressed amazement at how people sacrifice for the sake of God. The same spirit exists today in his Community.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that he has observed that it is often the less fortunate or middle-class who are at the forefront of making financial sacrifices. They understand that God will return that wealth back to them or they will receive the blessings of God in this world and the next.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that the Holy Prophet<sup>(sa)</sup> said that even if one were to offer a single date for the sake of Allah out of their pure wealth, then Allah will receive it and will continue to increase it until it becomes the size of a mountain, just as one raises a small child into a grown adult. So too will God increase one's wealth. However, the condition is that the wealth is pure and has not been illicitly earned.

## **Financial Sacrifice is a Means of Protection**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that on the Day of Judgement, a person will be shaded by the financial sacrifices they offered in this life. God states in the Holy Qur'an,

**'And he who fears Allah – He will make for him a way out, And will provide for him from where he expects not. And he who puts his trust in Allah – He is sufficient for him. Verily, Allah will accomplish His purpose. For everything has Allah appointed a measure.'** (The Holy Qur'an 65:3-4)

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that the Promised Messiah<sup>(as)</sup> has explained that God protects those who spend in His way from difficulties and provides for them in ways that they cannot even fathom. Those who spend in the way of Allah can never go to waste and can never be deprived of provisions and means. Those who place their complete trust in God are showered with bounties from the heavens.

## **Extraordinary Examples of Financial Sacrifice by Ahmadis Around the World**

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that by the grace of Allah, Ahmadis understand this and spend for the sake of the faith. There are countless examples of this every year. His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that he would present examples of those who offered financial sacrifices under Waqf-e-Jadid, and how they received blessings as a result. They were convinced that if they spent in the way of Allah, then he would certainly fulfil their needs.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that a lady in Indonesia was working as a part-time teacher and did not make much of an earning. She was informed that she still had an outstanding amount from her pledge for Waqf-e-Jadid. She had an amount of wealth which she had kept aside for herself. She contemplated and decided that though she needed the wealth, she would place her trust in Allah, spend the wealth in His way, and He would certainly bless her. As a result, only a short while later and completely unexpectedly, she was informed that she was receiving a bonus from the school she worked at and was also included in those approved for a government subsidy. She had also been waiting for a long time to receive her teacher registration number, which she also immediately received after making this financial sacrifice. She was convinced that these were blessings resulting from her financial sacrifice.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that a lady in Kenya, despite not having much of an income, has always remained regular in offering financial sacrifices. She emptied her pockets in order to fulfil her pledge for Waqf-e-Jadid. However, God did not leave her empty-handed. Just a few days later, she received a large amount of money from her daughter, who said that she could use this amount to fulfil her pledges and for her own needs. Similarly, her son-in-law gave her two cows. She had initially offered 400 shillings, and as a result, she began receiving blessings and bounties in far higher value, and in ways and from places where she did not expect whatsoever.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that a person from Australia fulfilled his pledge for Waqf-e-Jadid and then multiplied his contribution by six, and whereas his initial contribution was one thousand dollars, he increased it to seven thousand. The next day, he was informed by the insurance company that there was a claim in his family's name that he was not even aware of. As a result, he received twelve thousand dollars from the insurance company. He said that just in two days, his increased financial sacrifices were increased and doubled, all within the course of just two days.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that a man from India had an outstanding amount from his pledge for Waqf-e-Jadid. He had other important payments to make; however, he decided that he would first fulfil his pledge for Waqf-e-Jadid. When he was encouraged to offer half of his pledge so that he could meet his other needs as well, he responded by saying that God comes first and that He would provide for his needs. Later, he said that he received an amount which he had been waiting for, which had been held up for a long time. However, after making this financial sacrifice, the amount he had been waiting for and did not expect to receive so soon came into his possession immediately.

His Holiness<sup>(aba)</sup> said that a lady from Kyrgyzstan had asked her employer if her pay could be increased, and she was told that it could only be in the form of a bonus, but that was not guaranteed. When she was paid, she first offered her contribution for Waqf-e-Jadid, despite having many needs she needed to spend on. That same month, she was informed that her salary had been increased by forty per cent and that she would also be receiving a substantial bonus. This covered all her needs, and she was convinced that this unexpected blessing was all due to spending in the way of Allah. Similarly, she had another business that, up until then, had not been very successful. But right after spending in the way of Allah out of that which she loved and needed, the revenue from her business doubled.

## **Report of the Previous Year & Commencement of the 69th Year of Waqf-e-Jadid**




