**Allah, the Exalted:**

وَرَتِّلِ الْقُرْآنَ تَرْتِيلاً

*"And recite the Qur'an melodiously and thoughtfully"*

## Need of learning and teaching the correct pronunciation of the Holy Qur'an

### The Holy Prophet Muhammad:

(peace and blessings of Allah be upon him)

خَيْرُكُمْ مَنْ تَعَلَّمَ الْقُرْآنَ وَعَلَّمَهُ

*"The best among you is the one who  
learns the Qur'an and teaches it"*

## Need of learning and teaching the correct pronunciation of the Holy Qur'an

### The Promised Messiah:

(peace be upon him)

قرآن مجید کو بھی خوش الحانی سے پڑھنا چاہیے۔

*"The Holy Qur'an should be recited in a melodious tone"*



## Basic Points To Be Noted

- There are 29 letters in the Arabic Alphabet:

ا ب ت ث ج ح خ د ذ ر ز س ش ص ض  
ط ظ ع غ ف ق ك ل م ن و ه ء ي

- Arabic is written and read from right to left:

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ

## Basic Points To Be Noted

- Certain letters have 'thick' or 'thin' sounds:

(Say) قُلُّ      (Eat) كُلُّ

- Arabic has vowels which prolong the sound of a consonant letter :

(master) مُلِكِ      (king) مَلِكِ

## Short Vowels

- **Fat'hah** is a slanting stroke always placed above a letter:



## Short Vowels

- **Kasrah** is a slanting stroke placed below a letter:





## Short Vowels

- **Dhammah** is an inverted stroke placed over a letter:



## Short Vowels



**Fat'hah**



**Kasrah**



**Dhammah**

- Note: A letter having any of the above strokes must not be prolonged for more than one second.

## Long Vowels

- There are 3 long vowels in Arabic :



- These letters are also known as **Al-Huroof-Al-Maddah** (letters of prolongation or stretching)

## Long Vowels

- Examples of prolongation in English:

**F**ather  
**R**ather

## Long Vowels

- Examples of Al-Huroof Al-Maddah:

(نُ وِ حِ يَ هَا) نُوحِيهَا

(أُ وِ تِ يَ نَا) أُوتِينَا



## Surah Al-Naas

- This is the last Surah of the Holy Qur'an (Chapter 114)
- It has seven verses
- The meaning of its name is 'The Mankind' or 'The People'
- It is the best small Surah to learn the rule of Noon Ghunnah

## Rule of Ghunnah

- Ghunnah means continuous nasal sound for about two seconds
- There are two letters of Ghunnah:

**(a) Meem Ghunnah (مّ)**

**(b) Noon Ghunnah (نّ)**

## Rule of Ghunnah

- A Ghunnah letter carries a 'Tashdeed' sign over it:

### Meem Mushaddad and Noon Mushaddad

- Example of Meem Ghunnah:

## Al-Ta'awwudh

- Seeking refuge with Allah

**This is a command of Allah, the Exalted**

فَإِذَا قَرَأْتَ الْقُرْآنَ فَاسْتَعِذْ  
بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

*"And when thou recitest the Qur'an,  
seek refuge with Allah from Satan the rejected." (Al-Nahl 16:99)*



## Al-Ta'awwudh

- Seeking refuge with Allah

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

*"I seek refuge with Allah, from Satan the rejected"*

النَّاسِ ﴿٦﴾ مِنَ الْجِنَّةِ وَالنَّاسِ ﴿٧﴾



## Prayer after reciting the Holy Qur'an

اللَّهُمَّ ارْحَمْنِي بِالْقُرْآنِ الْعَظِيمِ- وَاجْعَلْهُ لِي إِمَامًا وَنُورًا وَهُدًى  
وَ رَحْمَةً- اللَّهُمَّ ذَكِّرْنِي مِنْهُ مَا نَسِيتُ- وَ عَلِّمْنِي مِنْهُ مَا جَهِلْتُ-  
وَ ارْزُقْنِي تِلَاوَتَهُ أَنَاءَ اللَّيْلِ وَ النَّهَارِ- وَ اجْعَلْهُ لِي حُجَّةً  
يَا رَبَّ الْعَالَمِينَ- آمين.

*“O Allah, have mercy on me through the Great Qur'an and make it for me the Model, the Light, guidance and mercy. O Allah, remind me whatever I have forgotten from it and teach me what I do not know of it. Grant me it's recitation during the hours of night and day and make it a witness in my favour, O Lord of the Universe.” (ameen)*
