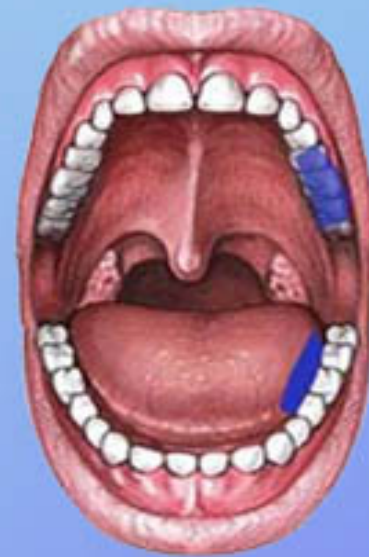
How to pronounce letter ض (Ḍaad)

- This is one of the most difficult articulation points
- This is a heavy letter and is pronounced with a thick sound
- It is articulated when the edge(s) of tongue touches the upper molar teeth
- This can be articulated from:

RIGHT side

LEFT side

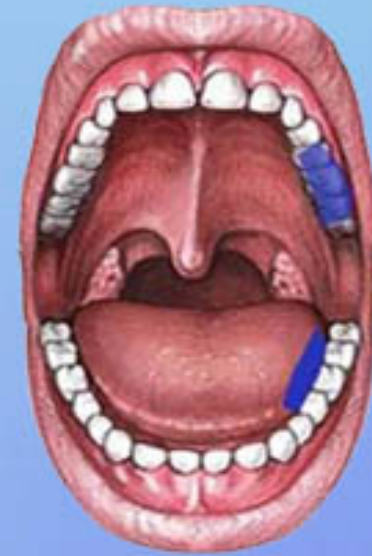
BOTH sides



How to pronounce letter ض (Ḍaad)

- To pronounce this letter correctly, place the left edge of your tongue to the edges of left upper molar teeth:

ضَهُ - أَض - أَضَّ



Point to Remember

This letter must not be pronounced like the letter

Daal د

Practice of letter ض (Ḍaad)

ضَهُ ضِهُ ضَّهُ

أَضُ إِضُ أُضُ

أَضِي أُضِي أُضِي



Practice of letter ض (Ḍaad)

Recite the following words without making pause (waqf)

At the end	In the middle	In the beginning
يَحُضُّ	يُضْعِفُ	ضِعْفٌ
الْأَرْضُ	يَضْرِبُ	ضُرِبَتْ
فَارِضٌ	يُضِيئُ	ضَيْفٌ
أَنْقَضَ	الْمَغْضُوبِ	ضَلَّ
