### What is the meaning of Idghaam?

### **Idghaam means:**

- Assimilation
- Blending
- Joining

#### Two Kinds of Idghaam (assimilation)

(1) Idghaam Bila-Ghunnah (Assimilation without nasal sound)
(2) Idghaam Bil-Ghunnah (Assimilation with nasal sound)

### **Idghaam Bila-Ghunna**

(Assimilation without nasal sound)

(ادغام بلاغنه)

### Summary of the rule regarding assimilation WITHOUT nasal sound

(ادغام بلاغنه)

Idghaam (blending, assimilation) involves two words

If the first word ends either with a Saakin Noon or with a Tanween and the next word starts with any of the following two letters ( ) ) then the assimilation will take place without nasal sound.

### Summary of the rule regarding assimilation WITH nasal sound

(ادغام بالغنه)

Idghaam (blending, assimilation) involves two words

If the first word ends either with a Saakin Noon or with a Tanween and the next word starts with any of the following letters (ئىنو دەرىن) then the assimilation will take place with a long nasal sound.
