Noon Saakin and Tanween

What is Noon Saakin?

- The letter ن with a sukoon is called Noon Saakin
- Noon Saakin may come either in between letters of a word or at the end of a word.

أَنْعَمْتَ - أَنْزَلَ - مِنْهُمْ - كُنْتُمْ -

مَنْ مِنْ إِنَّ كُنْ

Noon Saakin and Tanween

What is Tanween?

- Double strokes over or below a letter are called Tanween

سَوَاءٌ - رَغَدًا - عَيْنٍ

- Tanween can never come in between a word. It will always appear at the end of a word.
- Noon Saakin and Tanween have different shapes however their pronunciation is the same. They both produce nasal sound.

Special Rules concerning Noon Saakin and Tanween

Two kinds of nasal sound

- 1) Clear and short nasal sound of about one second
- 2) Sustained, concealed and prolonged nasal sound of about two seconds

*In this lesson we shall focus on
clear and short nasal sound
produced by Noon Saakin or Tanween*

Clear and short nasal sound

الاظهار

Al-Izh-haar

(The Manifestation)

*Clear pronunciation of Noon Saakin or
Tanween without prolonging nasal sound*

Huroof Al-Izh-haar

(Letters of Manifestation)

- There are 29 letters in the Arabic language. Out of the 29 letters, the following six letters are produced from the throat:

خ	غ	ج	ع	هـ	اء
6	5	4	3	2	1

These six letters are called:

حروف الاظهار

Letters of Throat or Letters of Manifestation

Rule to Remember

- If Noon Saakin or Tanween is followed by any of the six mentioned letters the nasal sound will be kept short and clear for about one second.

Examples for Practice

مِنْ عِبَادِنَا - تَنْجِئُونَ - مِنْهُمْ - مِنْ غَيْرِ - عَرْشٌ عَظِيمٌ
عَذَابٌ أَلِيمٌ - عَلِيمًا حَكِيمًا -

وَمِنْ شَرِّ غَاسِقٍ إِذَا وَقَبَ

وَمِنْ شَرِّ حَاسِدٍ إِذَا حَسَدَ

وَلَمْ يَكُنْ لَهُ كُفُوًا أَحَدٌ

مَا أَغْنَىٰ عَنْهُ مَالُهُ وَمَا كَسَبَ

وَأَمَّنَّهُمْ مِّنْ خَوْفٍ

وَأَرْسَلَ عَلَيْهِمْ طَيْرًا أَبَابِيلَ
